



# How to “White-List” a domain name in Gmail


1. Open your gmail page and select the “Settings” icon at the top-right of the screen:




2. Click “See all settings” :




3. Select the “Filters and Blocked Addresses” tab along the top:



4. Click “Create a new filter” :



5. Enter “mediterraneangardening.fr” into the ‘From’ item, and then click “Create filter”:



6. When the criteria box is displayed, tick “Never send it to Spam” and then click on “Create filter” :

← When a message is an exact match for your search criteria:

- Skip the Inbox (Archive it)
- Mark as read
- Star it
- Apply the label: Choose label... ▾
- Forward it [Add forwarding address](#)
- Delete it
- Never send it to Spam
- Always mark it as important
- Never mark it as important
- Categorize as: Choose category... ▾
- Also apply filter to 11 matching conversations.

Note: filter will not be applied to old conversations in Spam or Trash
