Programme of activities

Tuesday/Wednesday 14/15 May

Starting after lunch on Tuesday, we will visit a garden just south of Perpignan owned by one of the founder members of *La Société française d'acclimatation*, a new association which focuses on exotic plants. “At our December Branch AGM, we agreed to continue the Directory of Gardens started last year, but to remove the barrier of password protection, which was discouraging use of this section of the site. This has now been done and the Directory of Gardens can be accessed from the Home page.

So far, ten members have put details of their gardens on our MGS France website. They welcome other members getting in contact to make arrangements to visit them and their garden. Whilst we all find inspiration from the organised branch visits to important gardens throughout our region, there is just as much, if not more sometimes, that we can gain from informal visits to the gardens of other enthusiasts. These gardens are likely to be on a scale closer to our own, without the luxury of a paid gardener to do much of the work, and one can discuss in depth what does and doesn't work in this challenging mediterranean climate. There is a lot that we can learn from each other's ideas and experience.
